As you may know, Kenya is in a state of civic unrest due to the results of the Presidential elections held December 27. Most slum areas in Nairobi have had burning, looting, clashes with police, teargas, shootings, death. Much of western Kenya is worse...as well as other pockets of areas. Today Lynn called a Kenyan friend who lives in a village just outside Nairobi. He was saying how the food supply in their town was running low and there were no phone cards available to buy. This is what most Kenyans use with their cell phones. Lynn filled the Land Cruiser today with diesel...some places a gas shortage is now a problem. We are stocked on supplies and have been staying close to home. Kenya so needs our prayers...too many horrible things happening to innocent people...tribes against tribe it seems.

We plan to leave in the morning for the bush until Sunday...a trip we had planned with Crystal here. Most of Maasailand is quiet. We will be 6-7 hrs from Nairobi with poor or no phone coverage so will report back after returning.

Please pray for peace and stability in Kenya...our family and the CMF team's safety...that Christians across the tribes will unite in prayer and be the light in these dark times...that the violence will stop.

Guess I should say Happy New Year...altho in Kenya that is clouded over with all the unrest.
