Happy New Year from Kenya! Our family is well, having enjoyed the Christmas season all together here in Nairobi and a few days at the Indian Ocean. Sarah (our daughter) and Chris, her husband, just left this evening, back to California.

We are writing to ask you to pray for the country of Kenya. Results from the Dec 27 elections have been hotly disputed, leading to violence and killings in several parts of the country. There is a protest rally called for January 3, in Nairobi, and all are waiting to see what that leads to. People are afraid to go out, many shops have remain closed, and supplies of some things are starting to run low. There are not many vehicles on the road.

Our family is well, and we are now sticking close to home. We still go out to visit friends, to the store, to the school - all very close by. We are monitoring events through radio, phone, our network of teammates, friends from school, and Kenyans. The CMF/Kenya team has a well developed contingency plan that we are following.

Please pray for peace, for election results to be sorted out with integrity and transparency, for God's truth to be made known, for Christians to set good examples in this tense time.

Lastly, be assured we are safe, but know that volatile times are risky. So, your prayers are very important for all of us in Kenya!
